Presenting at conference is a **great opportunity** to be involved in the IMI networking and learning highlight of the year. We are keen to deliver a programme that appeals to beginners and experienced delegates alike and offer a warm invitation (*to IMI members and non members*) to think about sharing your skills and knowledge at the next IMI Conference in Clydebank, Glasgow.

We welcome abstracts from students and professionals working in medical illustration, photography, videography and graphic design, as well as healthcare sciences, people working in related fields and subject specialists, for **workshops, general/ scientific presentations, new voices** (short 8 minute presentations by first-time speakers) and also short 10-15 minute **'show and tell'** presentations.

Here are some suggested topics to consider however there are many more not on the list...

- Show and tell: have you been doing things differently since covid? Showcase your projects.
- Typography, font design, accessibility, social media graphics, animation, creating a brief.
- Colour management, workflow, 3D/ thermal imaging, AI, portraiture, bereavement, software, PR.
- DSLR videography, sound recording/ editing, two camera techniques, continuous lighting, video tips.
- Psychological safety, time management, effective communication, reflective practice.

If you are interested in taking part, submit an abstract using the form overleaf. This should include a concise description of your talk, detailing the project, issue or technique, and the lessons or ideas you would like the audience to learn from the session.

We would also like a brief biography; who you are, where you work, and your role and background in the field. Please also supply a portrait headshot (jpeg, 300 dpi).

Submission

Only electronic submissions accepted.

Note: Speaking at the conference is viewed as CPD activity and contributing to the profession. Speakers are therefore responsible for their own expenses, including registration, accommodation and travel costs. However, speaking at the meeting can also provide the justification for attending and lead to support from your organisation. So get your abstract in and take it from there!
